1. The minutes from the March 27, 2019 meeting were considered and approved.
2. Action Items:

MSN (CNL, NECS tracks) to required courses add NURS 6360

Philosophical and Theoretical Foundations for ANP and remove NURS 6347 Theoretical Foundation of Nursing Practice;

MSN (CNL, NECS tracks) to required courses add NURS 6306 Research Methods for ANP and remove NURS 6301 Research for Evidence-Based Practice I and NURS 6304 Research for Evidence-Based Practice II;

MSN-CNL track, to required courses, add NURS 6332 Health Policy for ANP;
