MINUTES

The Council of Deans met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. on April 8, 2020, via Zoom. Provost Patricia Poulter presided, and the following members were present: Jonathan Glenn, Michael Hargis, Jimmy Ishee, Victoria Groves Scott, Patricia Smith, Kurt Boniecki, Angela Barlow and Stephen Addison.

1. Welcome

- a. Each Dean provided a college update.
- b. Summer school logistics were discussed.
- c. P. Poulter provided clarification regarding the one-year COVID-19 tenure and promotion extension. The extension does not mean a person forfeits the opportunity to seek tenure and promotion as regularly scheduled. The extension allows individuals time to assess possible consequences to the portfolio in the primary areas of review as a result of the disruption of COVID-19. Should an individual determine they are ready to apply for tenure and promotion on their regular schedule, they may opt to do so. This application for tenure then follows all normal parameters, processes and levels of review.
- d. P. Poulter reminded the group that the deadline to withdraw from a course has been extended from March 30, 2020 to April 15, 2020, due to the midsemester shift to online instruction.
